

# WINNEBAGO COUNTY

The information presented here represents data specific to Winnebago County, Wisconsin from 2001-2006, and is meant to complement the report, *The Burden of Suicide in Wisconsin*. Please refer to this report for technical notes and suicide prevention strategies.

## KEY FINDINGS

Overall, the suicide rate in Winnebago County (per 100,000 population) was 11.1 in 2004, 9.2 in 2005, and 13.5 in 2006. Inpatient hospitalizations due to self-inflicted injuries were 125.8 in 2001, 138.2 in 2002, 136.7 in 2003, 121.4 in 2004, 140.4 in 2005, and 144.8 in 2006. Emergency department visits due to self-inflicted injuries were 60.3 in 2002, 71.2 in 2003, 65.0 in 2004, 59.7 in 2005, and 85.3 in 2006.
